Friday Afternoon at the Movies

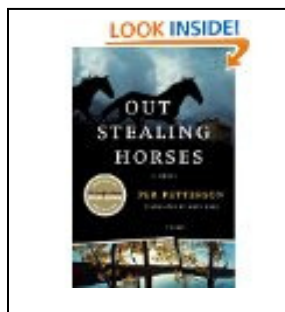

Half Day Café

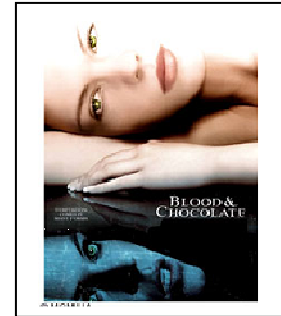

Earn volunteer hours and help make the library a better place! A small snack will be served.



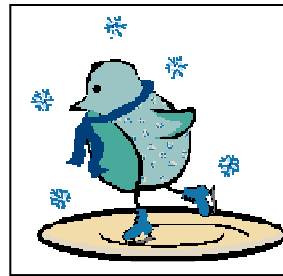
